## FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

Our business office team will be glad to submit the claim to your insurance company or Medicare for surgery center charges. Standard outpatient procedures are usually covered by your medical insurance or Medicare. You will receive separate bills from the surgery center, your physician, and your anesthesiologist. You may also receive a bill for any laboratory, pathology, or diagnostic services that you receive.

Depending on your coverage, you may be asked for partial payment upon admission to the Center. We make every effort to inform you of this amount prior to your admission. When you arrive for surgery, you should be prepared to pay all co-payments and your deductible if it has not been met.

For your convenience, we accept MasterCard, VISA, American Express, and Discover credit cards. We also accept cashier's checks, money orders, and CareCredit on the day of your procedure.

If we need additional insurance information, or if you need to make a payment at the time of your surgery, one of our business office team members will contact you prior to your procedure. He or she will collect necessary insurance information to assist with your registration process.

Services may be provided in this health care facility by the facility as well as by other health care providers who may separately bill the patient and whom may or may not participate with the same health insurers as applicable.

Patients and prospective patients should contact each health care practitioner who will provide services in the ASC to determine the health insurers with which the health care practitioner participates as a network provider or preferred provider.
